10 Rules for Investigations

1. Location - Inspect location during daylight hours prior to investigation, noting any safety concerns. Research your site prior to investigation.
2. Equipment - Clean and test all equipment before embarking on an investigation.
3. Permission - Obtain permission from property owners before conducting an investigation. Do not trespass on private property. Do not hesitate to leave if owner or authorities request. Be respectful of your surroundings. Keep area clean - leave nothing; remove nothing.
4. Clothing - Wear dark, non-reflective clothing on an investigation. Carry proper identification at all times.
5. Group - Never go alone on an investigation. Remain with your group or partner. Do not wander off by yourself during an investigation.
6. Guests - No unscheduled guests should accompany you on the investigation.
7. Record Keeping - Keep a thorough log of investigation experiences, noting date and time, atmospheric conditions, and special circumstances.
8. Safety - Leave any area that makes you feel uneasy or concerned for your safety.
9. Recording - Speak clearly, concisely, and in normal tone while recording audio. No whispering.
10. Photography - Do not photograph in inclement weather or in dusty locations during wind gusts. Do not smoke while using photography equipment. Be mindful of loose objects, camera cords, hair, etc while photographing. During cold weather, hold your breath when you snap a photograph. Avoid photographing near shiny objects; i.e. glass, mirrors & other reflective material that might cause lens flares.
